Over 450 Meal Baskets Distributed for Thanksgiving



A dedicated team of volunteers pitched in to help us pick up and distribute over 450 meal baskets to local families and organizations this past weekend as part of the Holiday Giving Project, more than in any previous year. We received generous meal basket donations from many local partners, including Stein Sperling, Landon School, Holton-Arms School, Unitarian Universalist Church of Rockville, St. Elizabeth's Catholic Church, Potomac United Methodist Church, and more. We are also extremely grateful to Rockville United Church for lending us space to store and distribute the meal baskets.

Our efforts now shift to the December holidays, where we will distribute additional meal baskets as well as gift cards and toys for over 300 teens and children. MKHC has kicked off the holiday season by giving thanks to the amazing volunteers and staff who make our work possible. We threw a volunteer appreciation event to celebrate all our volunteers and brought in cupcakes for Nurse Practitioner Week to honor specifically their contributions! MKHC wouldn't exist without the dedication and commitment of our volunteers.



November is Diabetes Month! Did you know that around 50% of the patients at MKHC are diabetic or pre-diabetic?



For Diabetes Month and throughout the year, we work to provide the resources, education, and support our community needs to live healthier lives.

MKHC hosted a Diabetes Wellness Day this month to offer free comprehensive diabetes exams including lab tests, foot exams and eye exams; guidance on avoiding complications related to diabetes; and educational resources, including nutrition advice, to help manage the condition. Twelve patients received care as part of this event.

MKHC's medical assistants and other staff also took part in an educational seminar on the treatment of diabetic wounds

offered by a medical student at Uniformed Services University.

Showing off the new clinic space hasn't gotten old yet - we welcome different groups to tour the office and get a first-hand look at our operations. Recently, we welcomed a group of supporters who attended an MKHC fundraiser and are interested in volunteer work. We also toured representatives from the Latino Health Initiative (right) as we explore ways to strengthen our partnership.



Volunteers should have an understanding of evaluations, the ability to do research to determine best practices, and good writing skills. Some experience in the area that is being evaluated is helpful but not necessary.
